The Korea International Cooperation Agency ("KOICA") was established in 1991 by the South Korean Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade as a governmental organization to enhance the effectiveness of South Korea's grant aid programs for developing countries by implementing the government's grant aid and technical cooperation programs. In 2018, KOICA entered into a 5-year program with IIX to build capacity of growth-stage enterprises to attract impact investments. As part of the program to train and facilitate the development of young Korean professionals, a Korean national (known as a KOICA Fellow) will be employed to support the program for a minimum of 2 years.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will assist the Impact Partners team to conduct Impact Enterprise (IE) and investor outreach. This individual will also work with and assess Impact enterprises to prepare them for Impact Partners listing (examining financial reports, business plans, understanding capital needs), guiding them to be investor-ready and managing their capital raising process. This work will include financial modelling and analysis, process management and building trusted relationships. The work scope also includes conducting impact assessments for IEs to measure and communicate the social and environmental impact. Impact assessment work also involves providing detailed projection and data collection tools as well as recommendations, to help magnify the social and environmental performance of an IE as well as to enhance the transparency and accountability to stakeholders and funders.

Successful candidate will be expected to commit to the role for a minimum of 2 years.

Qualifications:

Required:

- Holds a Korean passport
- For the analyst role, at least undergraduate degree in Business Management or a similar field, with a minimum of 1-year experience in a similar field. For the associate role, a Master's degree in development or financial economics, business administration, or quantitative or technical discipline is preferred.
- Strong analytical abilities, both qualitative and quantitative. Knowledge in financial modelling and analysis is required.
- Ability to present information in an insightful and structured manner, both written and oral.
- Entrepreneurial mindset; self-starter comfortable working in a dynamic environment.
- Professional communication skills in English; additional languages highly desirable.
- Desire to work in a collaborative, high-performing team environment, building relationships with other team members and managing a range of responsibilities.
